Free eBooks from your library! The QUICK Guide




- You will need your Amazon login information and your library barcode. Your Kindle will need to be registered with Amazon. You will also need a device on which you can browse the web.
- Connect your Kindle to Wifi: go to **Menu**→**Settings**→**Wifi** and connect to an available network.
- On a computer or web-enabled device which is connected to the internet, open a browser window and go to www.MyLibrary.us
- Go to **Online** → **Downloadables: eBooks, Audio eBooks, eMagazines & Music**
- Click **eBooks**, select **OverDrive**.
- **Sign in.** 
- In the top right corner select **My account** and **Settings**.
- Select your preferred period for checkout. Choose from 7, 14 or 21 days.

- Select **Subjects** or **Collections**, or use the **Search** box to find titles.

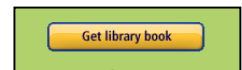

- To check out, tap **Borrow**. To see more details, tap the cover.

- To download, tap book icon from top right corner, select **Loans**. Next to your title, tap **Choose a Format** and select Kindle.



- You will be redirected to Amazon. On the right side, click the yellow **Get library book** button in the green box. If you are already signed in, you will get to select the device that you want the book delivered to.
- If not signed in to Amazon, you will be prompted to sign in. Once signed in, you should then get an option to deliver the book to your Kindle. Select **Continue**.
- On your Kindle, connect to Wifi and go to **Settings**→**Sync and Check for Items**. After a few moments, the book should appear on your home screen.
