



## Bookmobile RFP Response to Questions

March 27, 2018

1. Is the length of 30 feet final?

The length for the vehicle has been changed to 34 feet maximum.

2. You want two entry doors for the patrons?

Yes, it is our preference that the vehicle have two doors for patrons to access the vehicle. It is not a requirement.

3. What is the style preference, since the bus platform is not available?

The preference is not in the vehicle style, but in the ability to provide the services outlined in the RFP. Services we would like to provide besides access to library materials are storytimes, printings services, and computer workstations. We would like to include a public printer, but we do not have a printer model in mind yet. It would have to be a larger printer since it will be used for more than staff needs. We would like two computer stations for staff and two for our patrons. We are open to innovative ideas that fit our service needs.

4. Is there a need for a wheelchair lift?

Yes.

5. What would be the dimensions of the printer that you are considering?
