Downloading the Libby App and setting it up for the first time Visit your app store and download the free Libby App (search for Libby, by OverDrive) to your tablet or smartphone.

When you first open the Libby App, it will walk you through a series of questions to set up your account.

Search for a library using 80634 as your Zip Code.

Pick **High Plains Library District** as your library.

Decide how you want to read most of your books.

Enter the Library and tap **Add a Card** on the options screen. Enter your 14-digit library card barcode number (without spaces) and hit **Sign In**. The app will remember your card and any other library cards you enter. You can search for titles, authors or keywords or you can browse eBooks and audiobooks. You can check out, read, return and renew books through the Libby App.

You can have Libby on more than one device and Libby will sync your items across devices.

The Libby App is compatible with newer Android, Apple and Windows 10 Devices.

It is NOT available for **Kindle Fire** devices, but you can use it to send books to your Kindle.
