How to Participate: WRP 2022 Quick Guide

Download the **Beanstack Tracker App** and open it. If you are using a computer, you can visit: https://highplains.beanstack.org/reader365 to sign up or register.





In the app, tap **Let's Go!**, then tap **School**, **Library**, **or Bookstore** on the next screen.

Next, tap **Find a Site**, then search for High Plains Library District and tap **High Plains Library District (CO)**.

Next, you will be asked to Sign In or Sign Up!

If you have an account from SRA or 1000 Books Before Kindergarten, you can use it to Log In. Otherwise, create an account by choosing **Sign Up!** You will need to have a reader account to participate in challenges. Beanstack can support multiple readers of different ages under one creator account. If you have multiple readers in your app, be sure you're using the right reader to register for WRP. It will not be visible for readers under 16.

If you are the account creator, you can always Add A Reader to the account. You may be asked to fill out a brief reader profile. For the grade and school fields, you can choose Adult.

Registering for Winter Reading

Once your account is created, tap **Discover**. Scroll down to the **Winter Reading Program '22**.

Tap Join Challenge.

You should see a notice that you have received a badge for completing registration.

Logging Activities

From the **Home** screen, tap the Winter Reading Program '22 Challenge under **Current Challenges**. Tap **Activities**.

You should now see a list of **Activity Badges**. They are greyed out until completed.




Tap on the Activity to see instructions on how to complete it and for a reading list.
