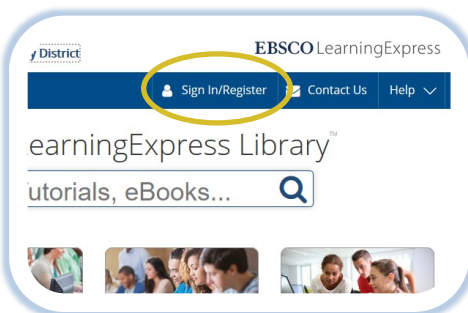

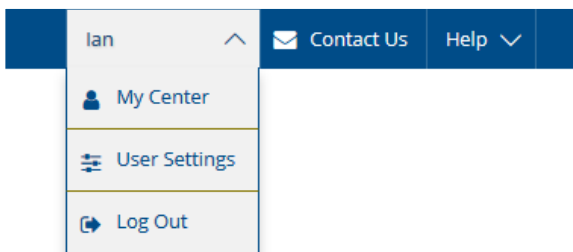

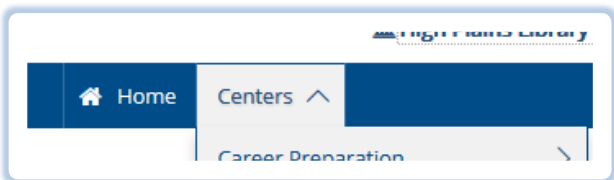

# Using Learning Express Library: Choosing a Subject

Learning Express Library has hundreds of practice tests for everything from passing the ACT to earning your CDL.

Hover over the “Centers’ menu on the blue ribbon for a list of topics covered in Learning Express Library.

### Our Grammar and Writing Skills

Grammar is a basic element of great writing, and mastering both skills is key to success.

The **Grammar Tutorial** contains the lessons and quizzes you need to learn and practice all the core elements of grammar. After completing the pre-test, take the lessons and quizzes, and end with the post-test and study plan to get a sense of how much your grammar has improved and what skills need more work.

Improve your grammar skills with **Grammar Practice 1** and **Grammar Practice 2**.

Improve your writing skills with the **Writing Skills Tutorial**. You'll learn an effective writing process—from brainstorming to the conclusion of the tutorial, you will write an essay that will be evaluated instantly, so you'll be able to see how you've improved in each of the skills essential to writing effective essays and papers.

Improve your writing skills with the practice sets, concentrating on the skills (**organization and focus**, **conventions**, or **sentence structures**) that still need improvement.

# Using Learning Express Library: Practice Tests

## Test settings can be customized based on your needs.

When you begin a practice test, you will be shown the test details and given the option to take the test as a simulation, practice or learner. Simulation replicates the experience of taking the real test while learner allows you to see answers as you go along without a time limit.

Tests in practice or learner mode can be saved to finish at a later time or scored at any point. These incomplete tests will be available for completion in My Center.
